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
INDICTMENT

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**THE ACCUSED** stands charged:



THAT it did, between September 2002 and June 2003, the exact dates being unknown, directly or indirectly, for the purpose of promoting Anitech Enterprises Inc.'s PetNet microchip and recovery service, knowingly or recklessly make representations to the public in the form of mailings to pet owners, which representations gave the general impression that payment of an annual administration fee was required to ensure continued pet registration and recovery services, which representations were false or misleading in a material respect, contrary to subsection 52(1) of the *Competition Act*, R.S.C., c. C-34, as amended.
